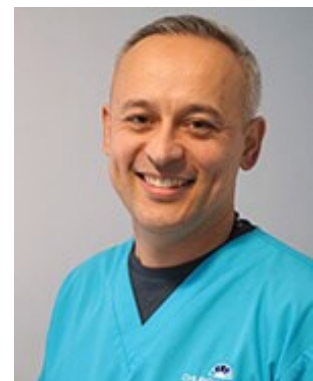

Oral cancer screening

What you can do :

Have regular dental check-ups ,at least yearly

Check inside your mouth with a small mirror for any changes that could be due to mouth cancer

Do not smoke

Do not drink alcohol, especially spirits

What your dentist can do :

We recommend an oral exam during your routine dental visit to screen for early signs of mouth cancer.

During an oral exam, your dentist looks over the inside of your mouth to check for red or white patches or mouth ulcers.

Many people have abnormal sores in their mouth and the great majority are harmless.

An oral examination can't tell which ulcers are cancerous and which are not.If your dentist finds anything unusual you may be referred for more tests to the hospital.
